In addition to tuition and fees for the academic year, indirect costs are also included in a student's Cost of Attendance calculation. The amounts of indirect costs listed below, are multiplied by the number of months in the student's academic year or period of enrollment. Tuition, books \& supplies and program fees for the program of interest are added to these indirect costs to comprise the Cost of Attendance (COA).

We also provide a calculated Pell Cost of Attendance (COA) for each student that receives a Pell Grant award based on the costs of attendance for a full-time student enrolled in the full academic year.

## LOAN FEES

For students who receive Federal Student Aid loans, the loan fees (if any) are also included in the Cost of Attendance (COA).

For all direct subsidized loans and direct unsubsidized loans for which the earliest disbursement date is on or after October 1 2016, the origination fee is $1.069 \%$. For direct PLUS loans the fee is 4.276\%.

The effects of the Budget Control Act of 2011 will continue into Fiscal Year 2018; direct subsidized and unsubsidized loans first disbursed on or after October 12017 and before October 1, 2018 will have an origination fee of $\mathbf{1 . 0 6 6 \%}$. Direct PLUS loans will have an origination fee of $\mathbf{4 . 2 6 4 \%}$.
