

As supply increases and eligibility expands in the state, the opportunity to receive the COVID-19 vaccine is expanding for our staff and students.

Below is a list of resources on where you can obtain additional information about the COVID-19 vaccine and some resources of places in our local communities that are administering the vaccine. Some of these places allow people to sign up to “save a spot in line” while others are just directly scheduling. Regardless, exploring different options may be advisable until supply is more widely available. For example, while a variety of pharmacies are offering the COVID-19 vaccine, capacity and supply at some of these locations may be more limited than health departments, hospitals, etc., so it’s good to check multiple places.

1. [COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at Ford Field](#)

FEMA in partnership with the State of Michigan and others will be hosting a mass vaccination clinic at Ford Field beginning Wednesday March 24, 2021 and continuing for 8-weeks. The plan is to administer 5000 vaccines per day. Appointments are required and will be scheduled a few days in advance. You may sign up now to ‘get in line’ one of these ways:

- Call the MDHHS COVID-19 Hotline at 888-535-6136 (press 1)

2. Check with your local health department in the county where you reside. Local health departments have additional info on vaccine availability. Some may also offer a “save your spot in line” list where you can sign up, and once you become eligible (and it is your turn in ‘line’) they will reach out to you to set up an appointment (Oakland County).
