

Associate of Applied Science in Nursing

What is the total cost of the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program within the normal time frame of 96 weeks of contact time (as published in the school catalog) scheduled over approximately 24 months currently totals \$54,600, which includes the cost of books and supplies. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

Total tuition includes an electronic device, a stethoscope, two medical scrub uniforms and a lab coat. Also included in tuition is the graduate's nursing cap, pin, and lamp for the pinning ceremony. Dorsey College will also pay the cost one-time for graduates of this program to challenge the NCLEX-RN (National Council Licensure Examination), including application and fingerprint fees, contingent upon the graduate meeting Dorsey College's exam preparation requirements. Dorsey College has determined that its Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program curriculum is sufficient to fulfill educational requirements for licensure in the State of Michigan only. No educational determinations have been made for any other state, district, or US territory in regards to the state board of nursing licensure requirements.

*Prior to enrollment there is a \$200 Application fee (which includes drug testing and personal background investigation) as well as a \$75 testing fee.
