What is the total cost of the Culinary Arts program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Culinary Arts program within the normal time frame of 48 weeks of contact time (as published in the school catalog) scheduled over approximately 12 months currently totals \$22,080, which includes the cost of books, knife kit and supplies. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

Total tuition also includes chef coats (2), chef pants (2), chef hat (1), and kitchen apron (1). Tuition also includes two nationally recognized certification exams. The first is the WFSO's Food Protection Manager certification exam, accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI)-Conference for Food Protection (CFP). The WFSO's program provides food safety training for foodservice leaders and managers. The second is the National Restaurant Association's Educational Foundation Nutrition Certification Exam. Students in the culinary arts program can earn certificates after passing these national exams. These certificates reward students for their accomplishment and serve as a resource to be used in the job search process. Further, industry hiring managers can look for these certificates when searching for top-shelf, qualified talent.
