



Emergency Medical Technician

What is the total cost of the Emergency Medical Technician program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Emergency Medical Technician program within the normal time frame of 22-24 weeks (based on a 10 hour per week schedule) or 11-12 weeks (based on a 20 hours per week schedule), as published in the school catalog, currently totals \$2,495. Fees include the cost of books, one uniform shirt (polo), clinical scheduler and tracker, and online testing access. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to repeat classes, withdraw, or interrupt training for any reason. Dorsey College has determined that its Emergency Medical Technician program curriculum is sufficient to fulfill educational requirements for licensure in the State of Michigan only. No educational determinations have been made for any other state, district or US territory in regards to licensure requirements.
