



Associate of Applied Science in Nursing

What is the total cost of the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program within the normal time frame of 96 weeks of contact time scheduled over approximately 24 months currently totals \$55,640. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

- Course fee of \$100 per course
- **TOTAL tuition and fees = \$57,540***
- *Prior to enrollment there is a \$200 Application fee (which includes drug testing and personal background investigation) as well as a \$75 testing fee.

What does my tuition in the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program include?

Tuition includes course e-textbooks, textbooks (except non-consumable textbooks will remain the property of Dorsey College), an electronic device, a blood pressure kit and stethoscope, and the graduate's nursing cap, pin, and lamp for the pinning ceremony. Two complimentary "medical scrub" uniforms and one lab coat are provided to all students enrolled in the associate of applied science in nursing program. Dorsey College will also pay the cost one-time for graduates of this program to challenge the NCLEX-RN (National Council Licensure Examination), including application and fingerprint fees, contingent upon the graduate meeting Dorsey College's exam preparation requirements. Dorsey College has determined that its Associate of Applied Science in Nursing program curriculum is sufficient to fulfill educational requirements for licensure in the State of Michigan only. No educational determinations have been made for any other state, district, or US territory in regards to the state board of nursing licensure requirements.
