



Baking and Pastry Arts

What is the total cost of the Baking and Pastry Arts program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Baking and Pastry Arts program within the normal time frame of 48 weeks of contact time scheduled over approximately 12 months currently totals \$22,320. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

- There is a course fee of \$225 per course.
- An Externship Fee \$500 (charged in final term).
- **TOTAL tuition and fees for the Baking and Pastry Arts program = \$24,170**

What does my tuition in the Baking and Pastry Arts program include?

Tuition includes course e-textbooks, textbooks (except non-consumable textbooks will remain the property of Dorsey College), a knife kit, an electronic device, chef coats (2), chef pants (2), chef hat (1), and kitchen apron (1). Tuition also includes two nationally recognized certification exams. The first is the WFSO's Food Protection Manager certification exam, accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI)-Conference for Food Protection (CFP). The WFSO's program provides food safety training for food service leaders and managers. The second is the National Restaurant Association's Educational Foundation Nutrition Certification Exam. After passing these national exams, students can use the certifications as a resource in the job search process as industry hiring managers consider credentials earned when searching for top-shelf, qualified talent.
