

Dental Assistant

What is the total cost of the Dental Assistant program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Dental Assistant program, within the normal time frame of 48 weeks of contact time scheduled over approximately 12 months, currently totals \$22,320. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

- There is a course fee of \$75 per course.
- An Externship fee \$500 (charged in final term).
- TOTAL tuition and fees for the Dental Assistant program = \$23,870

What does my tuition in the Dental Assistant program include?

Tuition includes course e-textbooks, textbooks (except non-consumable textbooks will remain the property of Dorsey College), an electronic device, and the graduate's cap and gown. One complimentary "medical scrub" uniform, a laboratory coat, and CPR certification are provided to all dental assistant program students. Dorsey College will pay the cost one time for graduates to challenge the RHS and the ICE certification exams, which are two components of DANB's CDA exam, contingent upon the graduate meeting Dorsey College's exam preparation requirements.
