



Pharmacy Technician

What is the total cost of the Pharmacy Technician program?

Tuition for a student to complete the Pharmacy Technician program within the normal time frame of 30 weeks of contact time scheduled over approximately 8 months currently totals \$13,020. Total tuition may change based on a student's decision to change programs, repeat classes, withdraw or interrupt training for any reason.

- There is a course fee of \$75 per course.
- An Externship fee \$500 (charged in final term).
- **TOTAL tuition and fees for the Pharmacy Technician program = \$14,045**

What does my tuition in the Pharmacy Technician program include?

Tuition includes course e-textbooks, textbooks (except non-consumable textbooks will remain the property of Dorsey College), an electronic device, and the graduate's cap and gown. One complimentary "medical scrub" uniform and one laboratory coat is provided to all students enrolled in the pharmacy technician program. Dorsey College will pay the cost one time for graduates of this program to challenge a certification exam as selected by Dorsey College, contingent upon the graduate meeting Dorsey College's exam preparation requirements. Dorsey College has determined that its Pharmacy Technician program curriculum is sufficient to fulfill educational requirements for licensure in the State of Michigan only. No educational determinations have been made for any other state, district or US territory in regards to licensure requirements.
